In reply to your letter of the 12th inst, respecting the date of build of the S.S. "SAINT ROMINIQUE" I beg to state that owing to labour troubles the construction of this vessel was greatly delayed, and owing to the re-construction of the Forth S.B. Co, the completion of the vessel has been still further delayed, the vessel having been laid up at the builders yard awaiting financial settlements. Under the circumstances I am of opinion that although labour troubles are not the cause of completion of the vessel being delayed till this time, it is reasonable to record a date later than 6 months after ^{launch} say the date of build January, 1922.
