Herewith we enclose First Entry Report on the

We may state that this vessel has left for
Newcastle with view to having Engine and Boilers installed
at that Port.

The under deck tonnage being assigned only a few
days before the vessel left it was not found possible to
verify the freeboard at this Port.

Due to the machinery not having been installed
the steering engine and the windlass have not been tried
out.

The gross tonnage having not been assigned we have
not been able to obtain the amount of fee for Special Survey
therefore no account as been rendered to the Builders, this
will be done immediately the gross tonnage comes to hand.
