Access Latch fitted on R. Q. deck aft of N°2 Hatch to N°2 Hold.
21" x 21" with $\frac{3}{8}$ " coaming 24" high. (fitted previously)

Hatches have steel W.T. Covers $\frac{5}{16}$ " thick with rubber, and butterfly screws.

Hatch to store aft has been removed at some previous date and
water-tight manhole fitted to deck.

A copy of this has been placed on board.

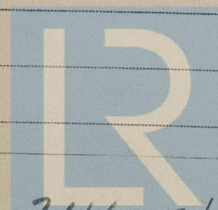
