Motorship "WALCRAG"

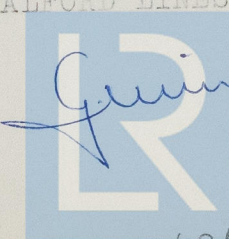
We acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 12th instant the contents of which we have read with some surprise.

The examination of this vessel was commenced at Rotterdam in February and was completed on that occasion with the exception of No.1. double bottom tank and cargo hold, which could not be examined as the vessel was loaded. We, therefore subsequently made the vessel available to your surveyor for examination of these two items and as far as we were aware your surveyor had then examined all items requested by him.

Having now completed all the work called for by your Rotterdam surveyor we cannot understand your request for information of the arrangements to complete the general examination of the hull and should be grateful if you would kindly explain to us what further items you wish to examine, and why your surveyor did not examine these items on the two previous occasions.
