Remarks. As a result of a General Examination carried out at Halifax in April/May last the Committee agreed to the Special Survey being postponed until the end of last month.

On the 6th January a proposal to postpone the Special Survey until the middle of the present month (two/three weeks beyond the year of grace) was agreed to on the definite understanding that this arrangement was adhered to.

Subsequently the St. John, N.B. Surveyor writes as follows:-

"I have now to advise that the vessel arrived at this port on the 10th instant, and I am today informed by the Owners' Representative that she has been taken out of service and will be laid up indefinitely at this port pending final decision by the Owners either to replace the vessel or to proceed with the Special Survey."
