I am in receipt of your letter of the 4th instant forwarding freeboard particulars for the Oil Tanker, Yard No. 121, proposed to be built by your goodselves, and, as desired, I have the pleasure to enclose a memorandum setting forth the freeboards which have been provisionally assigned, subject to the particulars and dimensions now supplied being verified on completion of the vessel, and to the ends of the erections being closed as required for full allowance.

The freeboards have been computed on a corrected tonnage coefficient of .76 and are subject to revision if found necessary.

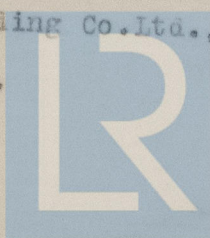
