The Second Special Survey No.3 became due on this vessel in May 1926, and has been partly held. Some repairs are required in the bunkers and to ventilators in the tween decks etc.

A proposal to complete the survey on the vessel's return from her contemplated voyage in two months was agreed to on the 8th February last.

The vessel arrived at Marseilles in June, and the Society's Surveyors at that port reported that she was being repaired under the survey of the Non-exclusive Surveyor of the Registro Italiano. The matter was pointed out to the Owners by the Genoa Surveyors, who now state that they have been informed by the Owners that owing to the age of the vessel, the necessity of classing her with the Registro Italiano, and for general reasons of economy, they have decided not to maintain the Society's classification.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, the 12th instant, when it was decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (8,27), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
