With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "HUMANITAS", I beg to remind you that the Second Special Survey No. 3 became due so long ago as May, 1926, and has not yet been completed. In addition repairs are required.

In February last it was understood that the survey would be completed on the vessel's return from her then contemplated voyage in two months' time from that date, but in a letter received from the Society's ^{recently} Marseilles Surveyors/it was stated that although the vessel was being cleaned and repaired at that port had not been called in to survey her.

The Committee have had the case today, together with a letter from the forwarding one from you dated 28th ultimo, in which you intimate that you wish to withdraw the vessel from the Society's classification, and in all the circumstances the Committee have had no alternative but to give instructions for the steamer's class to be expunged from

the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record in the Register Book of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled, and should be returned to this Office.
