We have received the interesting piece of the circulating pipe cut out of the Donkey Boiler of this vessel, which you kindly forwarded to Mr. Milton.

This clearly shows the danger of the arrangement fitted. So far as we know this arrangement was not fitted under the survey of our Surveyors in America, but I have had the piece of pipe cut in halves and forwarded one piece to Mr. Salmon at New York for his information.

I have suggested to him that, if he can find out who fitted the arrangement, he should show them the piece of tube cut out.
