I am sending in a separate box a portion of the circulator cut out of the ^{Donkey Boiler?} S.S. "ANGLO SAXON", which I think you will be pleased to have, illustrating as it does the danger of fitting such things in a boiler using ordinary sea or dock water.

The short time it has taken to nearly choke the pipe, if the statement of the chief Engineer is correct which there is no reason to question, is certainly a great source of danger.

At present there appears to be no burning of the pipe but it could not be long before this happened.
