One length of starboard side bilge keel, slightly buckled, and 11 keel plate connecting rivets to shell ban, started.

RECOMMENDED

Keel plate to be released and faired in place.  
Shell ban in way to be faired in place.  
11 slack rivets to be renewed.  
All disturbed part to be recoated.
