## QUESTION

With reference to my letter of the 1st January last addressed to the Owners through your port, to which a reply does not appear to have been received, I shall be glad to learn as soon as possible what early and definite arrangements have been made to carry out the Main Boiler Survey, due so long ago as October, 1959.

According to the records in this Office the ship was last examined in drydock by the Society's Surveyors in October, 1958 and information as to the Owners' intentions regarding a further drydocking survey will also be appreciated.

## ANSWER

Date:— 3rd May 1960. *24/5*

Owners state they were unable to reply to our previous inquiries because vessel is laid up since July 1959 in the Etang de Berre. Now they are not contemplating re-commissioning, but if they eventually were to do it they would then apply to be informed which surveys should be carried out.
