Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 30th September and referring to mine of yesterday 30th September regarding "ESSO NORMANDIE", I expect you are now in possession of the reply of the Owners dated 29th September concerning the two vessels.

Program for "ESSO BRETAGNE" is :

leaving tomorrow 2nd October Havre for Rastanura and back to Havre on 10th November.

Only one other voyage Havre - Rastanura - Havre, arriving that place on the 20th of December.

They are pointing the very most larger part of the voyages is made in parages where smooth or moderate sea is prevailing at the season, also large reinforcements have been already carried out on the vessels, and their captains have been strictly directed to obey the Memorandum regarding the loading and ballasting of tankers.
