Reverting to my letter of the 1st April last and previous correspondence respecting this case, I have to inform you that the report of survey carried out at Marseilles in January/February last has now received the consideration of the Committee.

To complete the Special Survey, the masts and rigging remain to be examined, and the after oil fuel bunkers examined internally and tested, and I have to inform you that the Committee are agreeable to this work being postponed until the structure in way of the cargo tanks is re-inforced, i.e. not later than before the end of October next.


