I beg to acknowledge receipt of your telegram of yesterday afternoon reading as follows :-

"Esso Bretagne your letter twentieth ultimo experience has shown electrical modifications necessary T2 tankers stop for classification survey necessary exclusively electrical surveyor attend and if survey to be appreciably advanced at Havre can arrange Auterson proceed there from this office please confer owners and wire if Autersons attendance desirable now".

Having taken the matter up with the Owners, I have to inform you that, before telling us when Mr. Auterson should proceed to Havre, they wish to know what modifications are required by the Society.

They add that the ship will return on the 7 th instant to Havre where she will stay four or five days.
