Dear Sir,

With reference to my letter and telegram of yesterday's date, respecting the "ESSO BRETAGNE", I am sorry to find that in the course of my conversation with the Owner, respecting the above vessel, neither the Owner nor myself we had in mind the contents of your letter of the 14 th instant (which had duly been conveyed to the former) regarding the hull.
