Foster Wheeler Requisition to cover inspection Order No. H-94343, Req. No. WE-818-13, Charge FWB-3598-3603 dated 4-9-52.

These fusion welded drums have been constructed and tested in accordance with the approved Plans and the Society's Rules for Welded Pressure Vessels, the materials tested to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors and the workmanship is, in my opinion, good throughout.

The drums were subjected to hydrostatic tests in the presence of the undersigned, afterwards examined, calibrated for circularity, and found satisfactory. Radiographs of all welds and stress relieving charts were examined and found in order.
