In reply to your letter of the 13th instant regarding our First Entry Report No. 5362 on the steamer "LUCIA" I have to inform you that the thickness of the upper sheerstrake, clear of the bridge, and of the frames and reverse frames at the solid floors in the double bottom are .90" and 7/16" respectively.

The thickness of the poop and forecastle beams are as required, viz: -.34 w and .40 flange.

The reported dimensions of the face bars on the web frames and the spacing of the bulkhead stiffeners are as approved.

Between the dates of 21st January and 11th May 1921 copies of all the principal plans, including bulkheads, decks, tank top, pillars and girders and panting arrangements were sent to the London office and should be found filed away there.
