The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

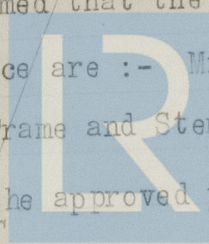

Nature of Survey _____

It is submitted before this case receives further consideration the Surveyors be requested to state whether the thickness of the upperdeck sheerstrake clear of the bridge and of the frames and reversed frames at the solid floors in the double bottom are correct as reported, as from the copies of the approved midship section in this office (which ^{is} ~~are~~ indistinct) it would appear that these thicknesses should be .90" and 7/16" respectively; whether the thickness of the poop and forecastle deck beams is as required, ^{& the} face bars on the web frames and spacing of the bulkhead stiffeners are as approved.

The Surveyors should also be informed that the only copies of approved ship plans available in this office are :- Midship section, general arrangement, Decks, Rudder, Stern Frame and Stem, and they should be requested to forward the remainder of the approved plans or copies of same.
