Motorship "DEBORAH"

The Committee have today had before them a request from the Owners of the above-named ship for withdrawal from class.

The position is that the ship was reported by the Rotterdam Surveyors early this month to have sustained collision damage in April, and the Surveyors recommended that permanent repairs to indented and wholed plating be dealt with on the ship's arrival at Bremerhaven. The Owners state that the ship is now classed with the American Bureau, so it is concluded the necessary repairs were satisfactorily effected while the ship was in your district.


It will, however, be very helpful for the Committee to have confirmation of this fact which will enable them to assign a notation of "Class withdrawn at Owners' request."
