I am in receipt of your letter of the 14th May regarding the chemical analysis sheet referred to in mine of the 6th. It is noted that this refers to the above ship, and was advised in your letter of the 8th May which has now been received together with the second chemical analysis sheet.

I would refer you to my approval letter of the 24th April, 1951, and cablegram of the same date relating to P.403 steel to be used in the construction of this ship and note that no reference to this steel appears on your First Entry Report No. 663.

The particulars of chemical analysis forwarded have been examined and, as these differ substantially from the analysis of steels recently approved under P.403 for the Yawata and Kawasaki Works, I shall be glad to receive your comments.
