Dear Sirs,

Motorship "FLORETA"

I acknowledge your letter of the 3rd instant and note the circumstances in which this ship is at present employed.

You will doubtless recollect that last May you approached the Society's Surveyors at Singapore for a postponement of the overdue Special Survey until April 1959, and this was agreed subject to a superficial examination being made of the vessel with satisfactory results during the last quarter of 1958.

It is obvious that it will not be practicable to make such a superficial inspection at Ceram ports, and I am glad to say that, in these circumstances, the Committee have now agreed to maintenance of class until the end of April 1959 without further inspection.

You must appreciate, however, that as the year of grace for this Special Survey will expire next February the Committee will not be prepared to grant any further extension beyond April 1959, and the survey must then be put in hand if class is to be maintained.

I would take this opportunity to remind you that the load line certificate issued by this Society will expire on the 28th February next.
