Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines  
in APRIL, 1932

Since carrying out the Annual Freeboard Survey, the following  
items have been amended as a wartime measure:

Forecastle front opening has been reduced (18" head plate)  
to 4'11" x 4'0" and a watertight door operated from outside  
has been fitted.

Bridge front and bridge end openings have been closed by riveted  
plates efficiently stiffened.

The Owners Representative stated that amended freeboard markings  
were not required.
