Feed, Lub.Oil, for X-hd bearings (for'd star'd), main feed, Boiler o.f.  
pumps. Port & Star'd lub.oil coolers. The Feed heater. Main (port &  
star'd) and auxiliary air receivers, and safety devices.  
Port & Star'd steam driven generators.
