if you will hand the certificates to the Owners in Hamburg.

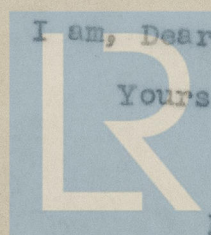
You will observe that the certificate for the
