

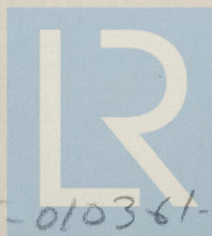

I have to acknowledge receipt of Mr. Turnbull's letter of the 27th instant relating to the classification certificates of this vessel and note that he has been in communication with the Engine Makers on the subject. With regard thereto, I regret to find that my letter of the 23rd was written under a misapprehension. As you are aware, the Engine Makers were not responsible for the payment of the fees for the survey during construction of the engines and in these circumstances they are not entitled to the machinery certificate, which will be sent direct to the Owners when the fees for the survey of the hull have been received.
