Motorship "DINGELDALE"

This ship was under survey at Bombay, in April/June, when the Special Survey of the hull was carried out in drydock, the Continuous Survey of the machinery completed and the Donkey Boiler and Steam Pipe Surveys held. A record of drydocking 6,58 and notations of S.S. Bom. 6,58, Continuous Survey 6,58, Donkey Boiler Survey 6,58 and Steam Pipe Survey 6,58 have been assigned. Classification Certificates in respect of the Special Survey of the hull and Continuous Survey of the machinery are enclosed.

The class of the ship has been continued subject to 15 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the earliest opportunity, and to the ballast pump water end, which was found to be wasted, being renewed by the end of June, 1959. I shall be glad to learn what arrangements you propose to make to have the equipment placed in accordance with Rule requirements.
