the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs, Ikegai Iron Works., Ltd, Tokyo attend at their works on the 10th September 1929, to examine under running test one 60 B.H.P. oil engine, started on gasolene and operated on kerosene, having four cylinders 130 m/m diameter and 160 m/m stroke, designated No. 7200, built to the order of Messrs, Yokohama Dock Co., Ltd, Yokohama and intended for their yard No. 177, for the purpose of driving emergency dynamo.

This engine has been tested in the shop direct coupled to a 35 K.W.D.C. generator designated No. 12418, built by Messrs, Mitsubishi Zosen Kaisha., Ltd, Nagasaki, under full rated load for four hours and afterwards tested under a ten percent overload for two hours and found to work satisfactorily.
