The Lanarkshire Steel Co., Ltd. attend their Works at Motherwell for the purpose of witnessing the testing of 4 Steel Stem Bars  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " of ship quality, stated to have been made from the same charge ( X83 ) as the 2 Steel Stem Bars  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " supplied to Messrs. Mitsubishi Zosen Kaisha, Ltd. Nagasaki, and intended for their Boat No. 486.

Samples taken from the  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " bars were subjected to the tensile and cold bend tests prescribed by the Rules of this Society for ship material with satisfactory results.

A copy of the results of the tensile tests is appended.
