With reference to the enquiry in your classing letter of the 5th inst., regarding the S. S. "WAR RANEE", Report No. 71078, I beg to state that strong beams are fitted in way of the oil compartments as approved, and that the butts of Bridge side plating are treble rivetted with $\frac{1}{2}$ " rivets spaced $3\frac{1}{2}$ " apart.

A copy of the Midship Section of the vessel as built was forwarded you yesterday and I have requested the Builders to forward to this office a copy of the Profile plan and this will be sent you when received.
