Dear Sirs,

With reference to the 2nd Special Survey N°3 which became due in April last year and to the limit which will expire at the end of the present month on the main boilers of the steamer "WIMBLEDON", I have to acquaint you that I am informed by the Owners that the vessel is expected to finish discharging at a Gulfport this week. She will then proceed to the River Plate whence she will return to the United Kingdom, and they desire the above matters to be left over until the steamer arrives home.

They state, however, that they are prepared to allow you to inspect the main boilers, but they add they do not wish to spend any money until the vessel gets home.

In reply they have been informed that their proposal to defer carrying out the 2nd Special Survey N°3 until the steamer's return to this country from the R. Plate about the middle of July is agreed to subject to the boilers being examined by you and favourably reported upon for the voyage home.


