Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "MALAY MARU",  
S. I beg to remind you that the Second Special Survey No.1 of this vessel became due in July 1925 and has not yet been completed. The year of grace allowed by the Committee for the completion of this inspection expired at the end of July last, and in reply to enquiry, the Society's Surveyors at Kobe state that you have informed them that it is not your desire to maintain the classification of the steamer in the Register Book.

The Committee have had the matter before them at their Meeting to-day, and I am directed to say that in the circumstances they have given instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and I cabled to the Society's Kobe Surveyors requesting them to inform you of the Committee's decision.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby
