NOW DONE:-

Vessel placed in dry dock. Hull, bottom, rudder, stern frame & stem cleaned, examined and found or how placed in good condition, afterwards recoated. Rudder lifted, pintles and bushes examined and placed in good order.

Holds, tween decks, fore & after peaks & chain locker, spaces under bridge, engine and boiler space and coal bunkers, cleared for survey, ceiling lifted all fore and aft, all oxidation removed from all parts, and all steel work throughout all parts of the vessel carefully examined and found or now placed in good condition, afterwards recoated, except those parts mentioned below.

Lining on ship's side part removed in way of Fo'cle sidelights and plating in way of same examined and found in good condition. P.T.O.

REPAIRS DUE TO WEAR & TEAR (Cont'd):-

Aft Peak tank top part doubled.

2 deck plates at aft end of No.4 hatch renewed and hatch coaming angle renewed.

2 deck plates abreast main mast renewed, 1 P and 1 S.

Floor and side girders at aft end of No.2 D.B.tank part renewed.

Tank top plate at aft end of No.2 D.B.tank on Starb.side doubled in way of bulkhead.

Water tight floor at forward end of boiler tank part renewed on Starb.side.

20 margin brackets in No.2 hold renewed on P & S sides.

1 " " " No.3 hold " " Starb.side.

Air pipes to Nos.1,2 & 4 tanks and sounding pipe to engine tank (No.3) part renewed.

Boiler room W.T. bulkhead part renewed at bottom.

Web plate and fore and after angle supports in all hatches repaired or renewed as found necessary.

Engine casing coaming on Port side Bridge deck part doubled.

4 plates to Engines and Boiler casing top renewed.

22'0" of Bridge Deck house, starb.side, plating renewed.

Windlass gypsy flukes built up with OA welding.

Boiler casings in tween deck side bunkers part renewed P & S.

The following requires to be done to complete SS NO.2:-

Wood lining in bridge space accommodation spaces P & S to be removed for examination.

Bridge space to be scaled and examined.

Tween deck bunkers (sides & cross) to be scaled and examined.

Margin brackets and gusset plates in Nos. 1, 2 & 3 holds to be further exmd.

Weather decks (in fore & aft wells) to be further examined.

Two centre girder intercostals in Fore Peak found thin, to be renewed.

NOTE:- *Permanent repair defect to callowian damage (at least) see Rpt. 4117^A*

The Owners' representative stated that the Special Survey No.2 will be completed next year when vessel returns for her annual overhaul, and in view of the repairs already carried out, this extension in my opinion may be safely granted. *HOB*



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
