Dear Sirs,

A. With reference to your first entry reports Nos. 6264, 6265, 6266, 6267 and 6268 on the Motor Coast Patrol Vessels "C.8", "C.9", "C.10", "C.11" and "C.12" respectively, I have to inform you that no Special Survey Request Form (Request 1) appears to have been received for these vessels and the same should be at once forwarded to this Office if they are in your possession. In the event of no Request Forms having been furnished by the Builders for these vessels I shall be glad if you will now obtain them and forward them here.

In this connexion I have to draw your attention to the fact that in your Quarterly Return No. 6 of vessels under construction, the information asked for in the Column headed "DATE OF AUTHORISATION OF SPECIAL SURVEY" has not been furnished.

It is important that this information should be included in the cases of all vessels building to Class with this Society, and I have to request that you will be good enough to give this matter your careful attention in future.
