Nature of Survey

First entry

It is submitted that before this case reaches the consideration of the Committee the Newcastle Surveyor should be informed that the vessel has proceeded to ~~South Shields~~ South Shields where her machinery is to be fitted by Messrs G. J. Lupton, and in order to complete the Survey for Classification the following repairs to be done:— the top of the engine & boiler casing & the engine room skylight to be riveted, & the tunnel top, with stiffeners & one stiffener on the coal shoot bulkhead to be riveted. They should be requested to give the case the necessary attention & on completion of the work to forward a report on form 8. with a view to the Classification of the vessel.
