

Messrs. Trenton Steel Works Ltd., attend their Works at Trenton, N. S.,
February 19th and 26th, March 5th, 12th and 18th, 1943, for the
purpose of testing and inspecting 5 rough machined intermediate and
tail shafts to the order of Messrs. Department of Munitions &
Supply and consigned to Messrs. Vancouver Engineering Works Ltd.,
Vancouver, B. C., Order Nos. 10,000-43-60, V16 and V16X.

The forgings were tested and inspected by me and found, so far as
could be seen, sound and free from defects.

The tensile tests and elongations taken from the forgings showed
as follows:-

The bend tests proved satisfactory, being bent through an angle of
180° without fracture.

The forgings were stamped as follows:-

2 intermediate shafts, Nos. 8073-88, LLOYD'S, 19-3-43, P.W.W.
3 " " Nos. 8127-29, 30, LLOYD'S, 19-3-43, P.W.W.
