Steamer "CAILLY"

The case of the above named ship has been submitted to the Committee at their meeting today in connection with your cablegram of the 18th instant, which reached this office in the following terms:-

"RE YOUR CABLE FIFTEENTH RECEIVED FOLLOWING CABLE FROM OWNERS TODAY QUOTE CAILLY CHANGED BY CLASS JULY LAST EDDIESHIP UNQUOTE"

It is concluded an error occurred in transmission and that the ship has been changed to BV class, and on that understanding the Committee have given instructions for a notation "Class withdrawn at Owners' request" to be recorded against the vessel's name in the Register Book.

If her classification has been transferred to any other Society, it will be appreciated if you will inform me by cable immediately as the Committee's decision is taken on the understanding that the vessel is now classed with another recognised Society.
