A letter has been received from the Amsterdam Surveyors in which they state that this ship has been bought by Messrs. Nitto Whaling Company Limited, Tokio, and was delivered on the 16th March.

The survey position is as follows:-

Special Survey due 7.62 (machinery
examined under the Continuous Survey
arrangement)
Press Boiler Survey due 10.60
Donkey Boiler Survey due 7.60
Port Screwshaft Survey due 6.62
Starboard Screwshaft Survey due 7.61
Steampipe Survey due 7.62
Ship last examined in drydock 12.60.

The class is subject to port main engine Nos.2 and 4 cylinder covers and starboard main engine No.4 cylinder cover being examined before the end of December 1962.

To complete the Donkey Boiler Survey and Press Boiler Survey the safety valves of all donkey boilers, except those of the forward and centre aft boiler on the forward stokehold, and of all press boilers remain to be adjusted under steam.

It is concluded the Owners will maintain classification with this Society, and I shall be glad to learn what early arrangements they propose making for the above safety valves to be adjusted.
