Further to our letter of June 27th in which we notified you of our decision to withdraw our steam trawlers from Class. We would like to take this opportunity of thanking you and your staff for your past co-operation and kind assistance.

It is with regret we terminate our pleasant association with Lloyd's, but frankly, this matter has been under consideration for the past few years. As you are aware we have actively endeavoured to dispose of these ships but have now reluctantly concluded that no market exists for steam trawlers.

It would seem to us, therefore, that there is no longer any advantage in retaining Class, and for reasons of economy we have decided to take this action.
