m.s. "CAROLINA PASSIO"

I acknowledge your letter of the 7th instant and have submitted the case of the above named ship to the Committee for consideration today.

The position is that the overdue Special Survey has been completed except for the examination of the main bearings of the main engine, and as intimated in my letter of the 1st August last a notation of "Laid up - S.S. incomplete" was then assigned.

In view of the Owners' decision to cancel classification with this Society they should be informed that the Committee have today given instructions for a notation of "Class withdrawn at Owners' request" to be inserted against the ship's name in the Supplement to the Register Book.

In arriving at this ruling the Committee consider they are granting a concession to the Owners for, strictly speaking, the class is liable to be expunged owing to non-compliance with the Regulations, but the Committee feel the position will be met if, when informing the Owners of the decision to withdraw class, you remind them that the main bearings have not been seen by our Surveyors since August 1951.
