I am favoured with your letters of the 9th instant enclosing plans, in quadruplicate, in connexion with Messrs. Corcho Hijos' Yard No.34 and Messrs. Hijos de J.Barreras' Yard No.520, and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that the plan of bilge and ballast pumping arrangement in the machinery space will be approved, provided the arrangements be as shown and amended thereon, the remaining requirements of Sections 20 and 34 of the Rules (1932-3) be complied with so far as they are applicable, and all the work be carried out to the entire satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

Further, the plan of circulating water pipes will also be approved.

Two sets of the plans are returned herewith, one set is being forwarded to the Society's Bilbao Surveyors for their information and guidance and the remaining set is being retained in this Office for reference.
