We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the ~~XXXX~~ Engines ~~and Boxes~~ of the Vessel No. **34** building by Messrs. **Corcho Hijos, Santander.** for Messrs. **C.A.M.P.S.A.**

of **1080** Tons. Length **180'** Breadth **36'-6"**, Depth **13'-6"** intended to be Classed *** 100A1.** The fees for the special survey during construction of the engines only being **£25 exclusive of any travelling expenses which may be incurred. (1)**

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
