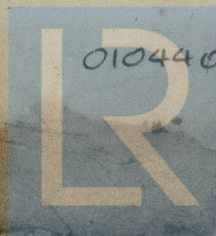
The 1st Special Survey No.1 became due on each of these Lake Vessels in April last.

In June last the Owners requested the withdrawal of their classification.

This is now confirmed by the Society's New York Office, who state they are informed by the Owners that their decision has been arrived at as these vessels are only used for Lake and River service, and their policy is to drop classification about the time the Special Surveys are due.

The Classing Committee had the cases before them on Friday, 7th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the character of each vessel to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
