13th instant relative to your Classing Letter of the m.v. "EMPIRE TIGOUVER", we have to confirm that in the opinion, the equipment of anchors, cables and ropes could be considered adequate.

The length and diameter of the cable is as given in our report and the length is one length less than wartime equipment for a vessel of equipment letter "J" which appears to be, by calculation, that applicable to this ship. The cable, however, was in good condition with practically no depreciation in diameter.
