With reference to Mr. Forster's telephone call on the 24th instant regarding these vessels, I have to say that the question of the postponement of the Screwshaft Surveys received consideration yesterday and it was decided that provided the wear down of the port shaft of the "DORA" be not excessive, the Committee would not insist on the shafts being drawn at this time.

It is considered, however, that in the interim certificates issued by you a statement should appear to the effect that the screwshafts have not been examined and that it is recommended they be drawn for inspection at the first opportunity.

The above decision was conveyed to you over the telephone yesterday.
