14646 "ADRIANA AUGUSTA" - This ship has today been classed + 100A1 "Carrying petroleum in bulk" together with the appropriate notations recommended by you.

It is concluded that the thicknesses of shell plating at ends are as shown on the plans and not as reported. In all future similar cases the thicknesses of shell plating at ends should be given in way of the peak bulkheads "as in vessel".

Confirmation is desired that the Profile Plan showing the ship "As built" has not been forwarded with your report, although advised in the Declaration of the report; also that the extreme breadth of the ship is 86' 4" in accordance with Circular No. 2051. Please forward a copy of "Equipment Calculation and details" referred to in Genoa letter dated 9th March, 1956, together with a plan of the cargo tank and hold hatchways and covers.

Concerning the machinery please let me know when a notice board is fitted and the tachometer marked in accordance with the Secretary's letter of the 30th September, 1957, reference 'Eng' and state the engine numbers of the two steam turbo generator engines, together with the date on which your Rpt.4c was forwarded to this Office, in order that this document might be traced.



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
