IT IS FURTHER SUBMITTED the Surveyors be advised it is concluded the thicknesses of shell plating at ends are as shown on the plans and not as reported, and be advised that in future similar cases the thicknesses of shell plating at ends should be given in way of the peak bulkheads "AS IN VESSEL".

They should be requested to confirm that a Profile plan showing the ship "As Built" has not been forwarded with their report as stated in the Declaration of the report, also that the extreme breadth of the ship (Circular No.2051) is 86'-4"

They should also be requested to forward a copy of "Equipment Calculation and Details" referred to in Genoa letter dated 9.3.56 and plan of cargo tanks and hold hatchways and covers.
