The circumstances in this raise a rather unusual issue in that the class of the ship has already been deleted from the Register Book and a notation of "broken up" assigned from an intimation received from the Madrid Office, dated 22nd May 1961, to the effect that the removal of some items had already started at Vigo.


It seems obvious that this is not a true statement in regard to the present position, but before taking any definite action, such as rescinding their previous decision, the Committee would welcome some further information in the case.

Will you therefore kindly let me know whether the vessel is again in service or whether she is in fact already laid up awaiting survey; and whether the new Owners have yet reached any definite decision as to her future.
