On 3.6.60 the Committee noted with some concern that the completion of the Boiler Survey might have to be postponed until 7.60 (9 months after the due date) and considered that the Owners should make efforts to complete the survey before the ship left Havana. On 7.6.60 the Madrid Surveyors stated that the ship has left Havana for New Orleans and the Canary Islands and will arrive at a Spanish port early in 7.60, when the Main Boiler Survey would be completed. The Committee agreed to this proposal on the understanding that the survey was completed without fail when the ship reached the Mediterranean.

The Madrid Surveyors now enclose translation of a letter received from the Owners, from which it is noted that the ship completed discharging at Alicante on 23.7.60 and was then to proceed to Vigo to be provisionally laid up until an improvement in the present conditions in the international freight market. The Owners wish to know whether it is necessary to complete the Boiler Survey immediately or whether it can remain in abeyance until the ship is again put into service.

Boiler survey should be held before vessel resumes service.
