On 3rd June, the Committee noted with some concern that the completion of the Boiler Survey might have to be postponed until July (9 months after the due date) and considered that the Owners should make efforts to complete the survey before the ship left Havana.

The Madrid Surveyors now state that the ship has left Havana and will arrive at a Spanish port early in July, calling intermediately for a limited time at New Orleans and the Canary Islands. Arrangements have been made for the Boiler Survey to be completed on the ship's arrival in Spain early in July.

The ship is 37 years old.

Submitted action might be deferred for a short time re Boiler Survey.
